EMPOWER THE PEOPLE

We make an extra effort in our trips and strive to be the most sustainable operator. We are witnesses that tourism does not go hand in hand with sustainability in many places.

One of our most recent projects, is to empower the people and the women of Pangkalan Bun. We will teach them to make meals without the use of palm oil and to produce and sell reusable bags, to get them to maintain income during the months without tourists.

We collaborate with the community directly by hiring local labor and buying food from the local markets, to boost the economy of the area.

We introduce the local culture, life and products like fruits, vegetables, meat and fish.

Coffee and tea are always bought in local stores.

Annually, we open new routes along with our guides, we organize projects to clean the water and join the project of fighting the fires in National Parks.

THE KLOTOK

The most used means of transport is the traditional Klotok. The wooden river boat is not only used to navigate on the waters of Indonesia;

it offers a unique experience, with excellent views.

Up to 10 travelers share the boat trips and the experience. We always recommend the shared trips instead of the private trips, to make our trip as sustainable as possible.

The Klotoks have a big gallon of drinking water on board, to provide everyone with fresh water. We save energy, by using large blocks of ice, to keep products cool for up to 3 to 4 days.

The Klotok is a traditional wooden river boat. We have different kinds of boats available.

The size of the boat depends on the number of guests who are joining the trip.

From small Klotoks, for only 1-3 passengers, till big Klotoks, for maximum 10 passengers.

The klotok has a roof on the upper deck.

From there, you can enjoy the view of the natural rain forest.

Klotoks are primarily used to transport people and goods.

They use them at the floating market to trade goods and to transport tourists through the rivers.





ECO-FRIENDLY ACCOMMODATIONS



Besides the Klotoks, which can provide accommodation for our travelers, we offer Eco-friendly accommodations.

Our offered accommodations are surrounded by rivers, National Parks and rain forests. All of our lodges are dedicated to educating and empowering local communities in long term conservation and sustainable development.

PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

Come2Borneo provides reusable drinking bottles. We only use organic and biodegradable products, such as 2in1 shampoo & shower gel, made of 100% natural and biodegradable with natural aromas.

By using the natural products, we help to reduce pollution to the river.

Used water from the shower and sink goes directly to the river. We add a new and unique detail to our Klotoks, so travelers can refresh themselves after the walks through the jungle. We replace the use of towels, by using biodegradable towels.



Do not purchase any products which contains palm oil, or in Indonesian 'minyak kelapa sawit'. Big international companies and local people burn down the rain forests to create areas for palm oil plantations.

Palm oil is processed in many products, for example: in crisps, cookies, margarine and chocolate. Per burned hectare rain forest, 6 orangutans get killed. Also, birds, snakes and pigs will not survive. The palm trees live up to 25 years. After that, the companies and the people burn down another part of the rain forest to start a new plantation. It is easier and cheaper to burn down another part of the forest, instead of seeding new trees at the same plantation and hire people to cut down the palm trees.

Unfortunately, it is still very difficult to always deliver palm oil free products. We try to work as little as possible with products that contain palm oil.

TAKE ACTION



We inspire travelers to take action, by protecting the animals and rain forests. We take our travelers to specific places during tours.

For example, travelers can choose to plant a tree for re-plantation or to visit the rehabilitation center.

We promote the contribution of the sustainability in Tanjung Puting National Park and motivate travelers not to purchase any products which contains palm.

Every traveler is part of the improvement of the National Park; 10 euros are automatically donated to environmental programs.

Our travelers are always well informed on how we conduct our trip, as well as what they are contributing to. Besides our automatically donation, we also recommend donating money to International Animal Rescue, Orangutan Foundation International or Friends Of The National Parks Foundation, to help the National Park, the rangers and the orangutans.
